The Cost of Following Christ

“Let it be known that on this day, I serve the God of Abraham, and Jesus Christ is my savior, and all should follow Him.”

An African village chief recently made this proclamation. He had been sick, to the point of hospitalization. Prayers to his tribe’s gods did nothing, and he still refused prayer from one of our African missionaries. It was only as death neared that this chief allowed our missionary to pray for him. This missionary prayed for healing and shared the gospel with the chief, and our God answered with a miracle! Upon his miraculous healing, this chief committed his life to Jesus and made his faith known to his village.

Pioneers has seen God move in mighty ways over this last year—especially across West, Central and North Africa.

Bishara's story, captured in a Pioneers podcast called "Maverick," is another encouraging testimony from this region. A new believer who used to be a Muslim and fled severe persecution, Bishara started a movement of faith in his country. At last report, 300 people are meeting in Bible studies and churches because of his evangelism!

The testimonies of Bishara and others are a great encouragement, but these new believers also face significant opposition.

Just recently, another new believer in West Africa died under suspicious circumstances. Opposition can come in many forms. As a Pioneers missionary in this region shares about new believers, *"They lose community. And they lose relationships. They are ostracized in a culture where relationships are everything."*

In the face of such opposition, it is vital that we continue to send new missionaries, to provide relationship, fellowship and discipleship needed by new believers.

As Pioneers continues to mobilize more American missionaries, we are praying that God also would raise up 65 new missionaries from West, Central and North Africa. Through our **2022 Co-Laborers Campaign**, you could help place new missionaries among 30 different unreached people groups!

1 Corinthians 3:9 says, *"For we are co-workers in God's service..."* Will you co-labor alongside us as a financial partner in this campaign?

Co-Laborers in Christ

Together, we can see amazing progress made for the sake of the gospel!

Across America, donors are banding together to recruit Pioneers missionaries, engage those still unreached by the gospel and strengthen new believers. This past year (2021), staff from Pioneers USA have been able to attend more face-to-face recruitment events and improve online recruitment strategies. This has helped us rebound from the pandemic. We hope to recruit 225 missionaries by the end of 2022, as we work to build a recruiting program that can identify 250 new American missionaries annually, by 2025.

God has also been at work in the Global South (Latin America, Asia, Africa and Oceania). Despite the challenges of the pandemic, Pioneers Egypt has equipped a second group of Egyptian and Sudanese trainees. Pioneers Africa is also recruiting new missionaries in West Africa at a faster rate than any other time in the last five years!

One congregation in Texas has supported a Pioneers missionary team in a predominantly Muslim country in West Africa. Through their partnership, this team was able to add four new African missionaries and develop a radio broadcast. This ministry publicly broadcasts scripture in the largest city of this unreached country, engaging over half a million people every week! As a co-laborer in this campaign, you can be used in the same way.

This coming year, you can be a part of:

1. Recruiting 225 new American missionaries, leveraging innovative recruiting strategies that reach more potential candidates.
2. Recruiting 65 new missionaries from the Global South, in partnership with Pioneers Africa and Pioneers Egypt (two of our 17 international mobilization gateways).
3. Sending missionaries to 30 different unreached people groups, like Muslim people groups in West, Central and North Africa.



Partners in God's Service

Let's labor together in relentless pursuit of God's glory among the unreached!

We need to raise \$2,500,000 for global missionary recruiting, training and sending in 2022. You can help us start 2022 strong by giving before December 31, 2021. Here is a breakdown of that goal:

- \$900,000 for mobilizing the American church to co-labor in a movement that can place new missionaries among at least 30 UPGs annually.
- \$600,000 for recruiting 225 American missionary candidates.
- \$500,000 for recruiting 65 Global South missionary candidates.
- \$300,000 for annual missionary training events in the US.
- \$200,000 for coaching of American missionaries preparing for the field.
